Department of Civil, Construction and Environmental Engineering Scholarship Instructions Fall Semester 2021

DEADLINE FOR ALL SCHOLARSHIPS: October 4, 2021, 5:00 pm

We are now accepting applications for our departmental scholarships. http://civil.unm.edu/admissions/financial-aid/civil-engineering-scholarships.html

To be eligible for these scholarships, you must:

- 1) be an <u>admitted</u> student into one of the three undergraduate degree programs or any of the graduate programs in the department at the time of your scholarship application;
- 2) meet the scholarship criteria;
- 3) supply all required information;
- 4) must be enrolled at least half-time (undergraduates at least 6-8 credits, graduate students at least
- 5-8 credits without an assistantship or at least 6 credits with an assistantship).

CCEE Department Scholarship Application Fall Semester 2021 is attached.

Complete ONE application, with all the required information, and write on the application the name of the specific scholarship(s) for which you are applying (and meet eligibility requirements). We will consider you for the scholarships which you list (and are eligible).

The application can be completed online if you download with Adobe Acrobat. Click on Fill & Sign at top right, then click on Add Text.

ITEMS REQUIRED with your application:

- 1) Your most recent UNM unofficial academic transcript (print this in LoboWeb).
- 2) Other materials may be required for certain scholarships; read the scholarship announcement carefully.
- 3) Some scholarships require financial need.

ONLY COMPLETE PACKETS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

<u>READ</u> THE SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA AND <u>ONLY</u> APPLY FOR THE ONES FOR WHICH YOU CAN QUALIFY. If you do not qualify, you are not eligible for that scholarship.

Some scholarships stipulate that you have financial need. If so, you must file the FAFSA for the 2021-2022 academic year. Your FAFSA must be <u>completely processed</u> through the UNM Office of Financial Aid by <u>our scholarship application deadline</u>, or you will not be qualified for consideration for those scholarships. (Note: international students cannot submit a FAFSA; open to U.S. citizens only.)
